## WHAT

After Jesus' death and resurrection, He was taken up to heaven and He left with a promise—He will come back one day. We can hold on to His promise, just as His disciples did. He is our returning King and we can wait for His return with anticipation, faith, and hope. In this lesson, we will look at three truths about the return of King Jesus.

### 1 Jesus is coming back to judge the living and the dead.

*In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead . . .* 2 TIMOTHY 4:1

<sup>31</sup>*"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his throne in heavenly glory. <sup>32</sup>All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats."* MATTHEW 25:31,32

Jesus, our King, came two thousand years ago to save us from our sin. And one day, He will return to judge the living and the dead. One day, we will give an account for how we lived. Though this may be a scary thought, as believers, we can rest on Christ's finished work on the cross. What is Christ's judgment for believers? How about for unbelievers?

### 2 Jesus is coming back when we do not expect it.

*But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. . .* 2 PETER 3:10

<sup>36</sup>*"No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. . ."* <sup>44</sup>*So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him."* MATTHEW 24:36,44

We do not know when Jesus will return—but He told us that this is not our concern. The Bible assures us that we cannot expect the day or hour. But what does matter is what we do while we are waiting for our King to return. Why do you think the Bible refers to the day of Jesus' return "like a thief"? What does it mean to "be ready"?
